## **Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice**

### **Be the Voice for Your Community**

### **Join us for our Fair Housing Public Workshops and Newly Added Topic-Specific Webinars!**

Many Californians are feeling the negative effects of the current housing crisis. We know that where you live can have long-term effects on health, access to education, and job opportunities.

In order to truly create A California for All, HCD wants to hear from all Californians on the issues and barriers they face in accessing housing, and to receive input from isolated communities where housing barriers may be compounded by other factors, such as: language access, physical limitations, and immigration status.

As a recipient of funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), the State of California is required to conduct a five-year Consolidated Plan (ConPlan) to develop housing programs and priorities for federal grant program years 2020-2024. As a key condition of the ConPlan, the State is required to affirmatively further fair housing and conduct an Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice (2020 AI). These plans will help establish community goals and guide federal resource allocations to encourage fair housing access and opportunity.
